

Attendance

This term has started with a 100% attendance for our Year 6 class. The children were very proud of this and very excited to receive the KS2 attendance award on Friday. Attendance at school is a high priority for us here at The Duke of Bedford and we appreciate your support to make sure that your children are in school daily and on time. Over the Easter break it was wonderful to see many of our children and families getting involved in some of the locally organised events such as the Easter celebrations at the Bedford Hall. With the 80th anniversary of VE day approaching we will be welcoming visitors to school to share information and introduce the children to a number of artefacts. We hope this will support the children to increase their knowledge and take part in the local anniversary celebrations with a better understanding of the significance of these. Year 3 are studying local history this term and will be delving further into significant places, people and events that have shaped that history so this will be particularly useful for them.
